The Mission of Kairos Outside

When people are incarcerated for crimes, family members also "Do The Time." It is a time of single parenting, limited income, lost holidays and birthdays, loneliness, shame, and few friends able to understand what they are going through. Kairos Outside is a special weekend retreat designed to support women who have been affected by incarceration. In a safe environment with loving people, women interact with other women who are in similar situations and learn to form small groups to support and give them strength for the challenges they face. Kairos Outside is an

international ministry with locations in most states and several foreign countries. Currently there are eight locations in Texas. Work on developing the KO Lubbock ministry began in 2009 with our first guest weekend taking place in April of 2011. Two weekends will be offered to guests each year. Frequently Asked Questions

Who may attend a KO weekend? Any female age 20 or over whose life has been impacted in any way by incarceration.

How long is the KO weekend? It starts Friday night at 6:00 pm and lasts until 5:00 pm Sunday.

How much does the KO weekend cost?

There is no cost to guests. The funds are provided by local Christian Communities and individuals.

Where do I stay during the weekend? Food and housing is provided free of charge to guests at the Mercy Retreat Center in Slaton.

Do any men participate on the weekend? All guests and team members you interact with are

female. A limited number of men serve on the team, but only to help with setting up the weekend and serving meals to the guests. Men are not allowed in the community room for the talks and discussions.

Do I have to be a Christian to attend the weekend? No — all we ask is that guests be open to discussion from a Christian perspective.

Why should I give up a weekend visit with my family member to attend a KO weekend?

Your journey is often difficult in a way many friends do not understand. This weekend is designed to give you support and encouragement from women who are in the same situation and other Christians who care about you.


