Loved ones invited to participate are called Guests. Guests share with each other how the incarceration of a loved one is affecting family life.

This weekend is a way to help strengthen the family unit and encourage small support groups for these women on the outside. We provide a secure place for women to share their struggles with each other and with those who are empathetic to their situations. The women on the outside, in many ways, have to be stronger than their relatives inside to survive in today's world. We hope Kairos 'Outside' will help them find strength for their life journeys and give them a chance to find and build friendships that may last a lifetime.


