We are one of the many groups that fall under Kairos Prison Ministry International, which is headquartered in Florida. We then have Kairos of Texas that has over 55 units – 10 of them being a Kairos Outside. Here are our Core Values:

We have an advisory council made up of 14-20 Kairos Outside of Midland volunteers. This is an elected group that serves in such areas as finance, outreach, fundraising, reunions, etc. We have a council meeting after each one of our reunions plus the 3rd Thursday in the months of March, July, and September @6:30pm at First United Methodist Church Midland. You are always welcome to attend any of these meetings.

As I said, there are 10 Kairos Outside locations in Texas – Amarillo, Central Texas (Waco), Corpus Christi, East Texas (Tyler), Houston, Lubbock, Midland, North Texas (Dallas), San Antonio, Wichita Falls. I want you to know so if the need arises, you can refer someone to one of the other areas to attend a Kairos Outside weekend. We have an ongoing network among each other to assist potential guests in finding the closest area to them and we need each one of you to be our ‘mouthpiece.’

Kairos Outside is very strong in Texas and we are fortunate to receive support from the men’s units (prisons) – both financial and as volunteers for our weekends. We, in turn, furnish one meal for a Kairos team meeting – Daniel (Snyder), Lynaugh (Ft. Stockton), Wallace (Colorado City). This gives us the opportunity to stay connected and present the Kairos Outside story.

Get Involved!

Team Volunteer--Working a team requires members meet for 36 hours to prepare for a Kairos Outside Weekend. Members share their special talents – musical, spiritual, social – with Guests and each other. The process begins with a volunteer application, which is submitted to the council and leaders of upcoming Weekends. Leaders begin choosing their team many months in advance, so becoming a Team Volunteer can take a long time because of all the planning involved.

Angel Volunteer--“Angels” are special volunteers who work behind the scenes during a weekend. They help prepare Guest quarters, set up tables and chairs, clean, cook, run errands, set up luminaries and pray during the weekend. We also need help with guest transportation during weekends.

Prayer Partners--In Kairos Outside, we depend on God to make things happen, so we recruit volunteers to pray for us from start to finish.

Agape--Agape is a sacrificial “love” that takes many forms. It could be prayer or working as an angel. Or it could be making little gifts such as bookmarks or food, for our Guests on the weekend.

Financial support--Kairos Outside of Midland is a volunteer organization that depends entirely on donations. We have two weekend retreats per year at an average cost of \$10,000 per weekend. Donations of any size are always appreciated. Remember, your donation is tax-deductible.
